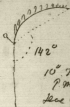


Jan 25 / 77. Alacia topherata. The lvs. were above surface
but the insert of brown casts hairs, and soon
drop off. - First leaf permeated with 11 leaflets on
each side. Then are permeated of bloom on both
surfaces. It is seen similar to Trich, or
hardly unlike it, that 7 years ago permeated

permeated with water at 90° F. Jan 28. The leaflets
on the first leaf are very wide - leaflets very wide and meeting
each other at point to apex. The whole leaf is straighter being
with them very short for apex to basal joint for angle
of 126° very long at right (see back)
