Aug 2. Lower belly very blue white - a few fine
hair on upper surface a narrow white patch, which
run to vent - eye, the second of which a narrow
thin white + above bright green.

Very fine in water 90-89 second most of
them for upper surface & all for lower.

August 4th at 10⁰⁰ water 88 & 89 for 1' (1m for side
traps consisted in leaflets) & 10m to leaflets between
with 100m; some amount in 1' 90⁰⁰ 5' 100⁰⁰,
& the 10⁰⁰ and in 100m of water.
at 9⁰⁰ 20' find 3 very leaflets, ^{on left side} 100m with water 89
along other leaflets & for in 100m in water
leaflets on opposite side.
