An invaluable supplement to Darwin's "Life and Letters." Some of the matter contained in the two volumes is highly technical, but much throws a pleasant light upon the writer's memories of childhood, his wide sympathy, and his appreciation of the work of others. Amongst the possessors of letters included here are Sir Joseph Hooker, Mr. A. R. Wallace, and Mr. John Morley, whilst certain letters of these to Darwin also find a place.
