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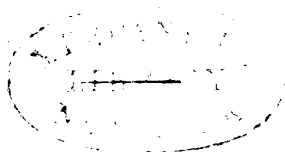
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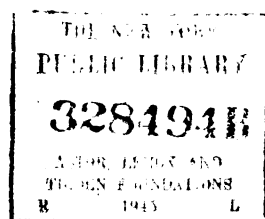

P R E F A C E .

THE Publication of this Catalogue, which various circumstances have unavoidably delayed longer than was anticipated, affords an opportunity of briefly explaining to the Public the principles on which THE LONDON LIBRARY has been established.

The object of those who have been instrumental in the formation of this Institution has been to provide the Metropolis of Great Britain with what is possessed by almost every other capital city in Europe, and indeed by every provincial town of any considerable size in the Empire—a Library from which books are taken out to be read at home. The want of such a Library, and the proposal to meet the want, were thus described in a pamphlet published in explanation of the scheme.

“There is, in truth, in London, no national Library whatever, from which books are allowed to be taken out, and which is thus capable of being compared with the great national Libraries of Germany and France, or of reciprocating to the foreigners who visit our metropolis, the literary advantages which Paris, Berlin, and Munich offer to Englishmen. Two lending Libraries indeed there are, which may be called public Libraries, and access to which may also be said to be generally procurable, namely, the Russell Institution, established about thirty years back, on the plan of a joint-stock-company, and the Library in Redcross-street, which is named Dr. Williams’s Library from its founder, and for which the public are indebted to the pious munificence of a dissenting divine. But neither of these Libraries contains so large a number of volumes as even the lending Libraries established in Manchester, Liverpool, Birmingham, and Leeds, can boast of. Neither of them contains more than 20,000 volumes. In neither of them has even the moderate number of volumes contained been selected in the best manner, for the purpose of a general Library. Such then is the state

of London in respect of lending Libraries. The metropolis of a nation boasting herself foremost in all the characteristics of civilization, and glorying in the pre-eminence of her arts and letters,—the city larger than any other city in the world, numbering no less than a million and a half of inhabitants,—the greatest, busiest, and wealthiest emporium of literature, known in the world's history, has no Library from which books may be taken out by the readers and authors who swarm within its far-lying limits, containing more than a miserable modicum of 20,000 volumes. And though sixty years and more have passed since the great historian uttered his complaint and his reproach, the deficiency which he stigmatised still remains a deficiency, and still is ‘the writer who has underaken to treat on any large historical subject, reduced to the necessity of purchasing for his private use a numerous and valuable collection of the books which must form the basis of his work.’*

“ We propose then to supply this great deficiency. We propose to establish a Library which, containing books in every department of literature and philosophy, shall allow these books to be taken out and read, where they can be read best, in the study and by the fireside, and which shall offer its advantages to the public on terms rendering it generally accessible. We propose to establish this Library by means of a subscription, so moderate that it can be grudged by none who feel the want of a large general comprehensive lending Library, either for themselves or for their families, and yet sufficient to ensure the establishment of the Library on an ample scale, with the support of all by whom the want of it is felt. And taking into consideration the increased and daily increasing facilities of conveyance to all parts of the United Kingdom, we propose to frame regulations which shall make it worth the while of persons in the country and at a distance, no less than of those living in London and its immediate vicinity, to avail themselves of the Library, thereby increasing at one and the same time its sphere of usefulness, and its means of supplying the wants of its subscribers. Not therefore only for the metropolis itself, but for all parts of the United Kingdom, between which and the metropolis there is easy and regular commu-

“*Education*, we propose to establish in London a large, general, comprehensive, cheap, lending Library.”*

Nearly a twelvemonth has elapsed since the Library was opened, and the Committee to whose care the formation of it was entrusted, are now enabled to come before the public with the evidence of the progress they have made in the realization of their scheme, and with a year's practical experience of the working of the arrangements adopted for carrying its objects into effect.

The present Catalogue exhibits the result of the past labours of the Committee, both as regards the *quantity* and the *quality* of the books selected for admission into the Library. The number of *volumes* comprised in the Catalogue already exceeds 13000; and if the number of subscribers to the Institution is not yet so large as their conviction of the great and general usefulness of the scheme had led the Committee to expect, the amount of the funds which the actual subscriptions have placed at their disposal has been such as never to retard their operations, and has enabled them to form a Collection far greater in point of number, and at an infinitely smaller cost, than they had previously, conceived to be possible within so short a period.

The titles of the books enumerated in this Catalogue will show better than any description the principles which have guided the Committee in the commencement of their “large, general, comprehensive” Library. Subject to one or two slight qualifications, which will be presently noticed, and with acknowledged deficiencies in several departments of literature, the character of the Library, as it now stands, will be that of the more complete collection which the Committee look forward to placing at the Subscribers' disposal at no distant period.

The Regulations originally promulgated for the circulation of the books among the Subscribers, which are reprinted in this volume, have, it is believed, in general, given satisfaction; and have been found by the Committee, so far as they are yet able to judge, successfully to combine the safety of the books with a very liberal practical developement of the lending principle.

In the selection of books, the only absolute limitations which the

Committee imposed upon themselves referred to new books of an ephemeral character and technical or professional works. The London Library was not designed to compete with Circulating Libraries, or with Libraries of a special or professional character, with those of the Inns of Court for instance, of the Royal Society, or of the College of Surgeons or Medical Society.—*New* books were not to be bought, unless the author's name, or the subject, showed that they were likely to be desirable in a good general collection; and even in these cases, a sufficient number of copies could not be purchased to satisfy the demands of Subscribers without drawing too largely on the funds of the Library. Subscribers cannot reasonably expect for their very moderate annual subscription to enjoy advantages which can be obtained from a Circulating Library, only for a Subscription of many times the amount.

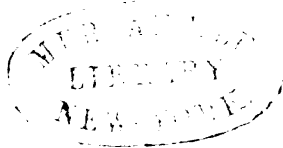
The Committee have been anxious to administer the funds at their disposal with economy, as well as judgment in the selection of books. It is necessary, unless a Library is formed with reckless expenditure, to wait for many books till they occur at fair and reasonable prices. Time is absolutely requisite to form an extensive Library at any moderate cost.

The Committee, without neglecting the general interest, have been desirous, as far as possible, to consult the wants of the Subscribers; and may have postponed the purchase of some valuable standard works, in order to provide others, perhaps less intrinsically valuable, but actually and earnestly required by Subscribers.

The Committee have to acknowledge several considerable donations of books from various Subscribers, more especially of a valuable selection of the best German authors from his Royal Highness Prince Albert, the Patron of the Institution; and they look forward with some confidence to this source, as likely to bring many important additions to the stores of the Library.

This is also the place for commemorating, with suitable acknowledgments, the bequest of *twenty-five pounds*, made to the Library by the late Rev. P. S. H. Payne, Fellow of Balliol College, Oxford, which has been recently paid into the Library Funds by his Executors.

LAWS AND REGULATIONS

OF THE

LONDON LIBRARY.

CONSTITUTION.

I. The government of the London Library shall be vested in a Committee, consisting of the President, four vice-Presidents, three Trustees, and of twenty-four other members chosen at the annual general meetings, six of these twenty-four to go out of office annually, but to be re-eligible. The President, Vice-Presidents, and Trustees shall hold their offices for life, and any vacancy in these offices shall be filled up by the Committee, to be confirmed by the General Meeting.

II. The Committee, of whom three shall be a quorum, shall have the entire administration of the affairs of the Library, subject to the Laws. They shall order all books, appoint the officers and servants of the Institution, enforce the observance of rules, impose fines and disqualifications, and manage the receipts and disbursements.

(a) The Committee shall meet periodically, at such times as they shall appoint, to examine the accounts, and to transact any business which may require their attention.

(b) All payments shall be made by cheques, signed by the Librarian, and countersigned by the acting chairman of the Committee at such meetings.

(c) Minutes shall be entered of all proceedings at such meetings, and at the commencement of each meeting the minutes of the preceding meeting shall be read over and confirmed.

III. In the month of May in every year, commencing with the year 1842, on a day of which the Committee shall give due notice, a General Meeting of the subscribers shall be held; who shall receive the report of the Committee, elect new members of the Committee for the ensuing year, auditors, or other annual officers, and make such alterations in the laws and regulations as they may think fit.

IV. In their report the Committee shall include a full statement of the pecuniary affairs of the Library, balanced up to the 1st May preceding, and audited by two auditors appointed by the Society at the previous annual meeting.

V. On receiving a requisition signed by a hundred members, the Committee shall at any time convene a Special General Meeting for any purpose stated in the requisition, or they may call such a special general meeting at their own discretion, stating the purpose in the notice given of the meeting: and such meeting shall have power to dispose of any question so stated, but not farther to exercise the functions of the annual general meeting.

VI. Any member intending to propose a change in the Laws in the form of a motion, shall give written notice of his intention to the Librarian one month before any General Meeting, which notice shall be publicly exhibited in the Library. The decision of the General Meeting upon any such proposal shall be by ballot, which shall be kept open for two hours. It shall be open to any member at the meeting to move an amendment upon the original motion without having given notice of his intention to do so, the adoption or rejection of such amendment to be determined by show of hands; and the main question, in the form thus decided upon, shall be put to the ballot. But if an amendment should have been adopted, of which a fortnight's previous notice should not have been given, the ballot shall be adjourned for a fortnight.



SUBSCRIPTIONS.

I. The subscription to the London Library shall be at present six pounds entrance, and two pounds annually, and no member shall be admitted to the privileges of the Library till he shall have paid the entrance, and one year's subscription.

Foreigners temporarily resident in England shall be admitted as Subscribers, without the payment of any entrance fee, at three pounds per annum.

II. Members may at any time commute their annual subscriptions by a payment of £20.

III. Persons who wish to become subscribers shall send their names to the Librarian, to be submitted to the Committee for their approval.

IV. The Committee shall have the power of declaring any member to have ceased to belong to the society, in pursuance of the laws imposing such a penalty: subject to an appeal to the General Meeting.

V. Subscriptions are payable on the 1st of May in every year. If any member fail to pay his subscription, together with all fines, expenses of carriage, and other sums due on the 1st of May, (having received notice thereof) on or before the 1st of July following, no more books shall be issued to him. If the subscription and such other sums be not paid on or before the ensuing 1st of January, the subscriber's name shall be erased from the books, unless the delay shall be accounted for to the satisfaction of the Committee.

VI. Members absent from the British Islands for the space of twelve consecutive months may, on giving notice to the Committee, retain their names on the books and be relieved from the payment due within that period, and so on for every further period of not less than a year.

VII. The bankers of the Society are Messrs. Bouverie and Co., 11, Haymarket, who alone are authorized to receive subscriptions.

VIII. The funds shall be vested in Trustees, and the first Trustees shall be the Earl of Clarendon, the Earl of Devon, and P. Pusey, Esq. M. P.

LIBRARIAN.

I. The establishment of the London Library shall consist for the present of the Librarian, and of such servants as the Committee shall consider necessary.

II. The Librarian shall attend in the Library daily at such hours as the Committee shall appoint, (from 11 to 6) and shall deliver out and receive all books required or returned, keep the accounts of the Institution, assist when required in the purchase of books, and generally conduct the business of the Library under the direction of the Committee. He shall also attend the meetings of the Committee and the General Meetings, in the capacity of Secretary.

III. The Librarian shall deliver out no books without a written order or receipt signed by the party who borrows it.

IV. The officers and servants shall be respectively liable to make good any injury which may be occasioned to the books or other property of the London Library by their default or negligence.

USE OF BOOKS.

I. Every member residing within ten miles of the General Post Office, London, shall be entitled to take out any number of volumes not exceeding ten, and every member residing at a greater distance any number not exceeding fifteen, at a time, any of the volumes to be exchanged for others as often as required.

II. The subscriber who takes out any book shall pay the carriage of the same and all expenses from the time of issue from the Library to the time of its return ; and shall be liable to pay the full price of the book, or of the work of which it is a part, if it is lost during that interval, unless the loss shall have been occasioned by the default of any person employed by the Society. And if during

that interval any book shall be defaced or injured, the book, or the work of which it is a part, may, by order of the Committee, be sold, and the subscriber in whose hands it has suffered such injury, unless the injury shall have been occasioned by the default of any person employed by the Society, shall be fined the amount of the difference between the price at which the book is sold, and that at which it was purchased for the Library. Or, if the work has been presented, the price at which it was published, or at which another copy, equally good, may be procured.

III. If application is made for any book which has been taken out two months before, the Librarian shall give notice to the subscriber who has borrowed the book to return it: and the subscriber shall return the same within one week from the issuing of notice, if he is resident within ten miles, and within a fortnight if more than ten miles. The time allowed for the perusal of *new* books is as follows: for an octavo volume, or one of smaller size, of 400 pages or less, a *fortnight*; and *three weeks* for a volume in folio or quarto, or one in octavo or lesser size, which *exceeds* 400 pages. A book is considered *new* for two years subsequent to the date of its publication.

IV. All books shall be returned to the Library on or before the 1st of July in every year.

V. Any subscriber who keeps a book beyond the time at which it ought to be returned under either of the above rules, shall pay a fine of one shilling per volume; to which shall be added one shilling per volume for every fortnight that shall elapse until such book is returned. If not returned in six months, the subscriber shall pay the full price of the book in addition to the fines. No other books shall be issued to him until all books due under the above rules are returned.

VI. The Committee shall have power, under special circumstances, to remit the fines due from subscribers, or to extend the time of payment.

VII. The Committee shall have power to determine on the classes of books which, except on special conditions, are not to be taken out of the Library.

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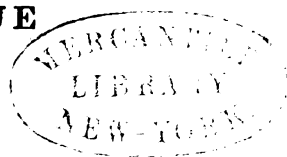
