






FIG. 1. Humerus




Fig. 1. *Falco Gyrfalco*.






Fig. 1. *Strix Delicatulus*.






Fig. 1. *Podargus Humeralis.*







Fig. 1. *Pedargus Humeralis*.


Figs. 1. *Centropus Phasianus*.,, 2. *Tauracus Gigas*.,, 3. *Pteroglossus Barbatus*
