P R E F A C E.

HE following Catalogue of the Diurnal Lepidoptera of Australia has been chiefly compiled from Mr W. F. Kirby's Catalogue of the Diurnal Lepidoptera of the World.

Without the assistance derived from that very laborious and really useful work, it would have been quite out of my power to have given either a complete or correct list of the Butterflies of this country.

I have not however, in following Mr. Kirby on most occasions, adopted him in all. I have, for instance, not followed him in his new arrangement of the Families, but have adhered to the old system of beginning with the Papilionidæ, and ending with the Hesperiidæ.

I much question also the propriety of his placing all the Australian *Ornithopteræ* as varieties of the Amboyna species *O. Priamus* *Linn.* They are no doubt very much alike, but I cannot admit that there is any evidence of their being varieties. *O. Richmondia* has its peculiar marking and habitat, both of which are constant. The same may be said of *Pronomus*, *Poseidon*, and *Cassandra*; and I believe that in no instance have specimens been found, in which it can be said that any one of these species runs into the other. It seems to me that these *Ornithopteræ* have as good a claim to be ranked as species, as any Insect can have in these days of Lamarckian belief. I have therefore restored in my Catalogue the genus and the species, both of which were ignored by Mr. Kirby.

In the genus *Papilio*, I have omitted *Xuthus*, and *Scottianus*, both indicated as Australian species by Mr. Kirby. The former I am sure never was taken in this country, and the latter is not a species at all, it is a mere variety of *Macleayanus*.

To the Pieridæ I have added one species, *P. Aruna Boisd.*, which has been frequently taken at Cape York, and I have included in the genus *Pieris* the genera *Tachyris* *Wall.* and *Delias* *Hüb.*

The Danaidæ remain as in Mr. Kirby's work with two exceptions, *D. Affinis Fabr.* (most unaccountably treated by Kirby as a synonym or variety of *D. Plexippus Linn.*) I have placed as a distinct species, as it undoubtedly is, and I have added *D. Erippers Cram.*, as that American species has for the last four years been a most common Butterfly along the whole Eastern Coast of New Holland. Some of the species of *Euplœa* are unknown to me, and I strongly suspect that they come from some of the Islands of the Pacific, but in the absence of positive proof to the contrary, I give them a place in my Catalogue. For the same reason I retain *Acroea Theodote Walleng.* on the list, though I am pretty sure there is no such insect. *Cynthia Arsinoë Cram.*, *Rhinopalpa Sabina Feld.*, and *Hypolimnas Alimena Linn.* I have added, as I have seen specimens of them from Cape York, Rockingham Bay, &c. *Hypolimnas Lasinassa Cram.* (placed by Mr. Kirby as a synonym of *H. Bolina Linn.*) I have reinstated as an Australian species, and *H. Misippus Linn.* I have omitted, as it is clearly not Australian. I have also omitted *Nymphalis Caphontis Hew.* The specimen which Mr. Hewitson received from Mr. Damel, and from which he described the species, was I know, taken at Fiji.

The only changes I have to notice in the remaining families are the additions to the list of the following species not recorded as Australian by Mr. Kirby:—*Libythea Myrrha Godt.*, from Cape York; *Cupido Ancyra Feld.*, *Cupido Cneius Fabr.*, *Cupido Perusia Feld.*, *Hypochrysops Epicletus Feld.*, *Amblypodia Centaurus Fabr.*, and *Ismene Exclamationis Fabr.*, all from Queensland.
