father's letters with a view to a

to my grandfather, the late Dr  
Robert Chambers who was a  
friend of your father's. The latter

"Water" mentioned in the second letter  
was one of a series of pamphlets,  
published under the general

the last of which appeared in 1661.  
They are, nearly all, now very scarce.

We must have other letters of  
your father's mixed up amongst  
old literary papers &c, but the  
enclosed are the only ones I have  
yet been able to discover. Should
