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## PREFATORY NOTE.

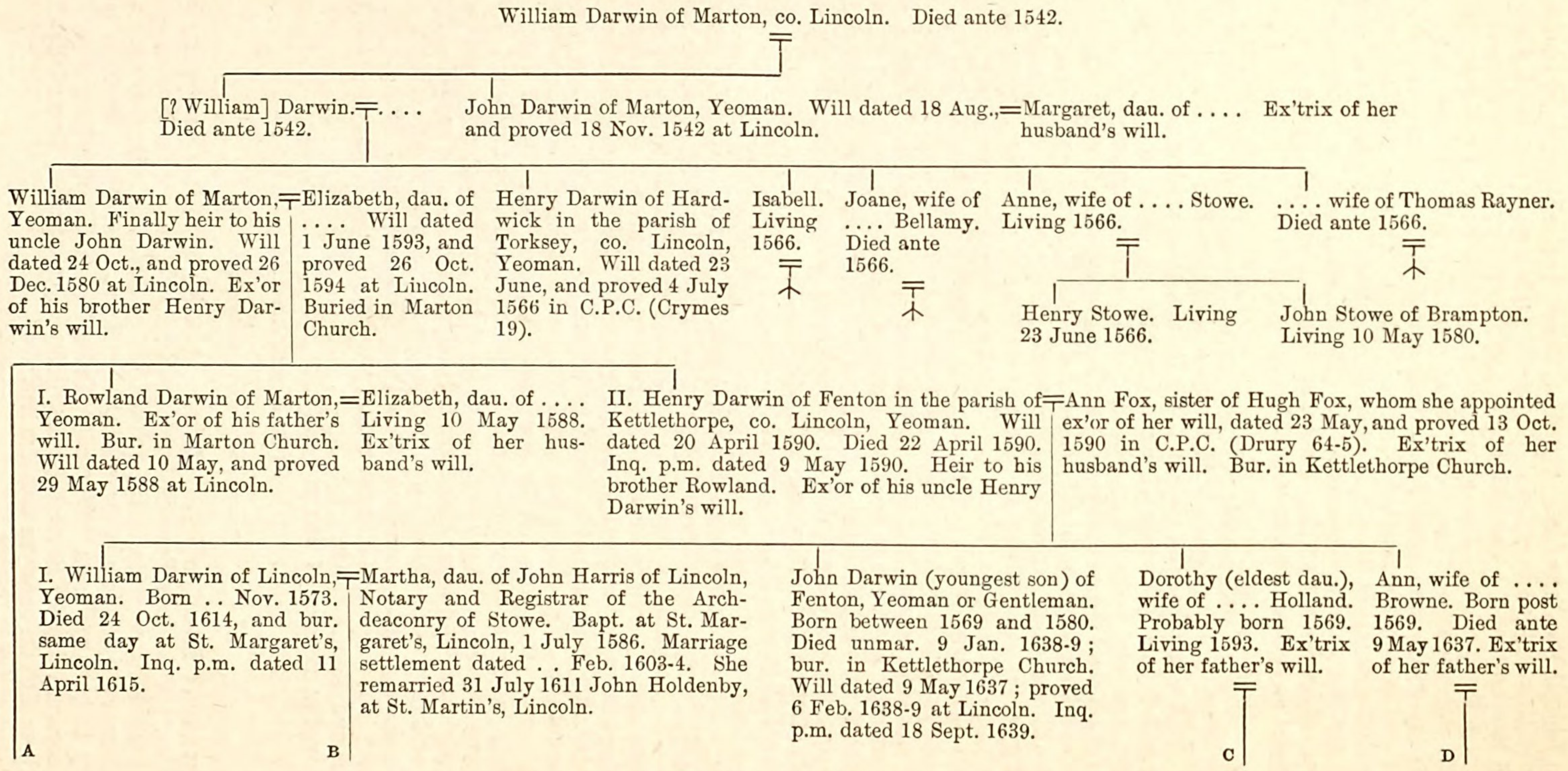
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ANOTHER Volume has now been completed, and the Editor trusts that it will be found not inferior in interest to any of its predecessors.

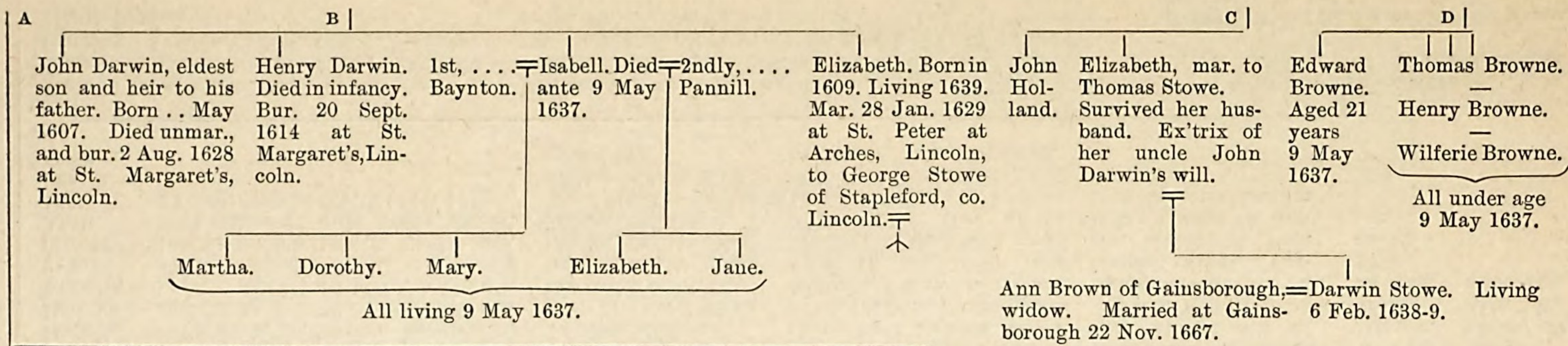

# Pedigree of Darwin.\*



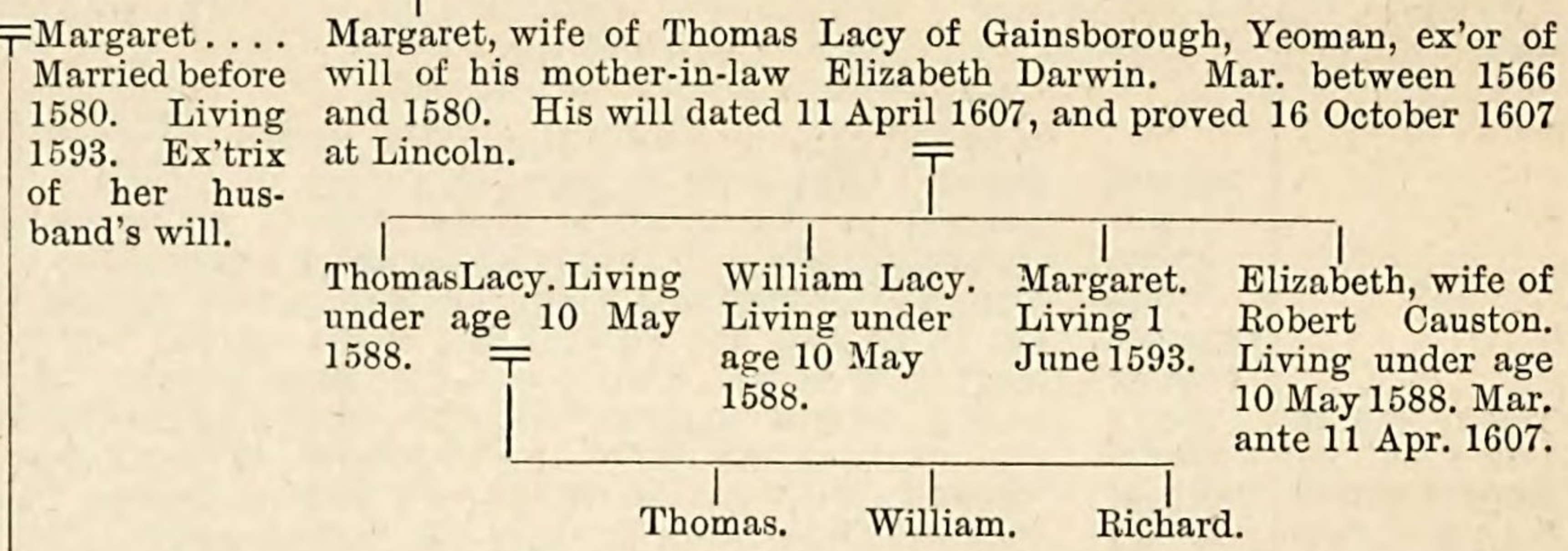

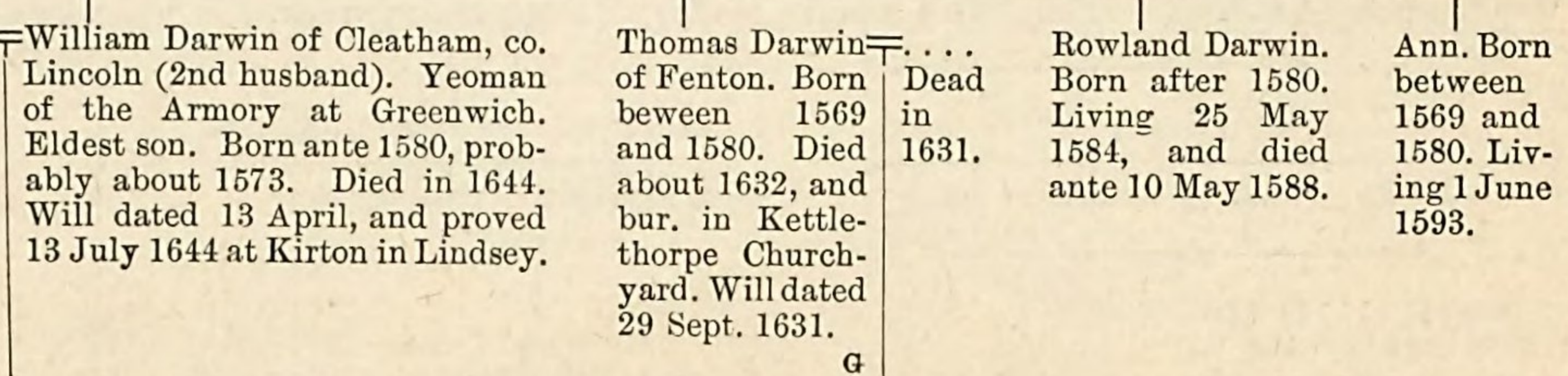

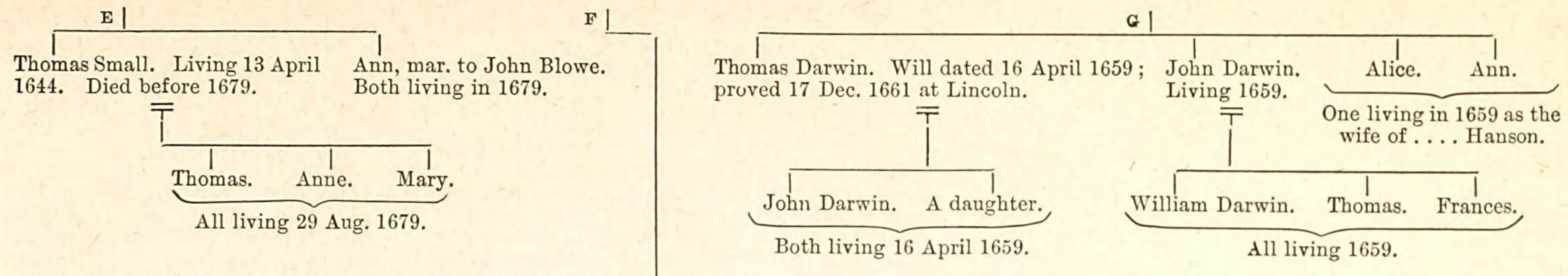
Signature of Richard Darwin from a terrier of the Glebe of the Vicarage of Marton dated 1577, in the Episcopal Registry at Lincoln.

Ex'trix of her husband's will. Will dated 29 Aug. 1679; proved 11 Sept. 1679 at Lincoln. On the seal attached to this will are the following arms: On a bend between two cotises three escallops.





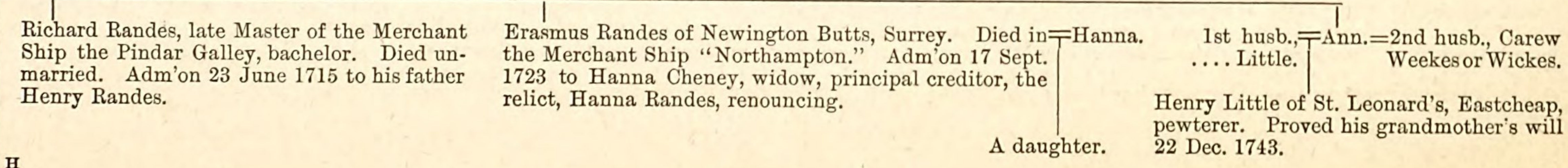
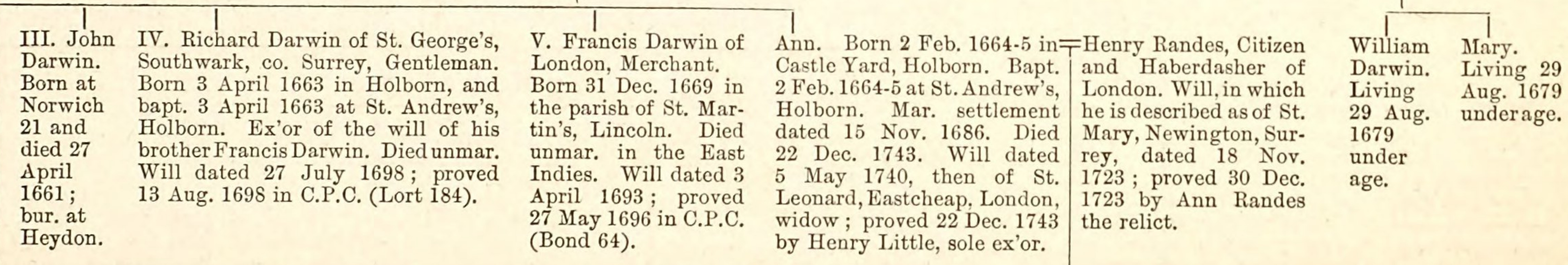
William Darwin of Lincoln's Inn. Born 6 June 1620. Ex'or of his father's will. Marriage settlement dated 2 June 1653. Recorder of the City of Lincoln. Will dated 20 Feb. 1673-4; codicil 24 Aug. 1675; proved 23 Nov. 1675 in C.P.C. (Dycer 110).

Anne, dau. of Erasmus Earle of Heydon (son of Thomas Earle, Esq., of Salle, co. Norf., by Anne, dau. of John Fountain, Esq.), by Frances, dau. of James Fountain of Salle, Esq. Born 24 April, bapt. at Heydon 1 May 1634. Married 30 Aug. 1653 at Clerkenwell Parish Church, co. Midd. Ex'trix of her husband's will. In her will, dated 22 Aug. 1691, described as of St. Andrew's, Holborn, co. Midd., widow. Bur. at Manton 2 Dec. 1691. Erasmus Earle, Esq., was bapt. 20 Sept. 1590. Of Lincoln's Inn 7 April 1612. Secretary for the English at the Treaty of Uxbridge, with Thurloe and Milton. Serjeant-at-Law 1648. Recorder of Norwich and Member also during the long Parliament. Own Serjeant to the Commonwealth to Oliver and to Richard Cromwell. Pardoned by King Charles II. 21 June 1660. Buried 10 Sept. 1667. Will dated 31 Aug. 1667; proved in C.P.C. 29 Nov. 1667 (Carr. 149-150).

Thomas Darwin. Living 1679 and probably 1695-6. Ex'or of the wills of his father and brother. | Elizabeth, dau. of . . . Adm'on of her estate granted in the C.P.C. 19 Feb. 1695-6.

I. William Darwin. Born 27 July 1655 at Southampton Buildings in the parish of St. Andrew's, Holborn, co. Middx., and bapt. there 5 Aug. following. Died 28 and bur. 29 Aug. 1682 at Elston. M.I.

Anne, only dau. and heir of Robert Waring of Wilford, co. Notts (who was buried at Wilford 12 Feb. 1662), by Anne his wife, who mar. secondly George Lascelles of Elston. Became possessed of Elston Hall, co. Notts. Bapt. at Wilford 16 Jan. 1662. Mar. at Heydon 9 Sept. 1680. Died at Elston 23 May 1722, aged 58 years. Will dated 18 May 1722. Bur. 26 May following in chancel of Elston Church. M.I.

II. Erasmus Darwin of Hull, co. York, Alderman. Born 8 July 1659 in Castle Yard, Holborn. Ex'or of the wills of his mother and brother Richard Darwin. Died 8 Jan. 1736 in Holborn; bur. 10 Jan. following at Hull, aged 77 years.

Elizabeth, dau. of Hugh Mason of Hull. Living 27 July 1698.

Signature of Anne Darwin to a note dated 16 May 1716, addressed to her son William.

Robert Darwin of Elston, co. Notts, and of Lincoln's Inn, Barrister-at-Law. Born 12 Aug. 1682. Died 20 Nov. 1754 at Elston, aged 72; bur. at Elston. M.I.

Elizabeth, dau. of John Hill of Sleaford, co. Lincoln. Born 18 Dec. 1702. Mar. 1 Jan. 1723-4 at Balderton, co. Notts. Died 26 April 1797, aged 94; bur. at Elston. M.I.

Elizabeth, mar. to her cousin William Darwin.

Signature of Robert Darwin to a deed, dated 23 April 1713, granting an annuity of £50 to his mother Anne Darwin out of lands at Elston.

Signature of Elizabeth Darwin to letter dated 14 Nov. 1757.

1st wife, Elizabeth, dau. of Erasmus Darwin of Hull. Born 1688. Mar. 15 Aug. 1706 at St. Mary's, Hull. Died 9 June 1713 at Newark, aged 25 years; buried at Elston 12 June 1713. M.I.

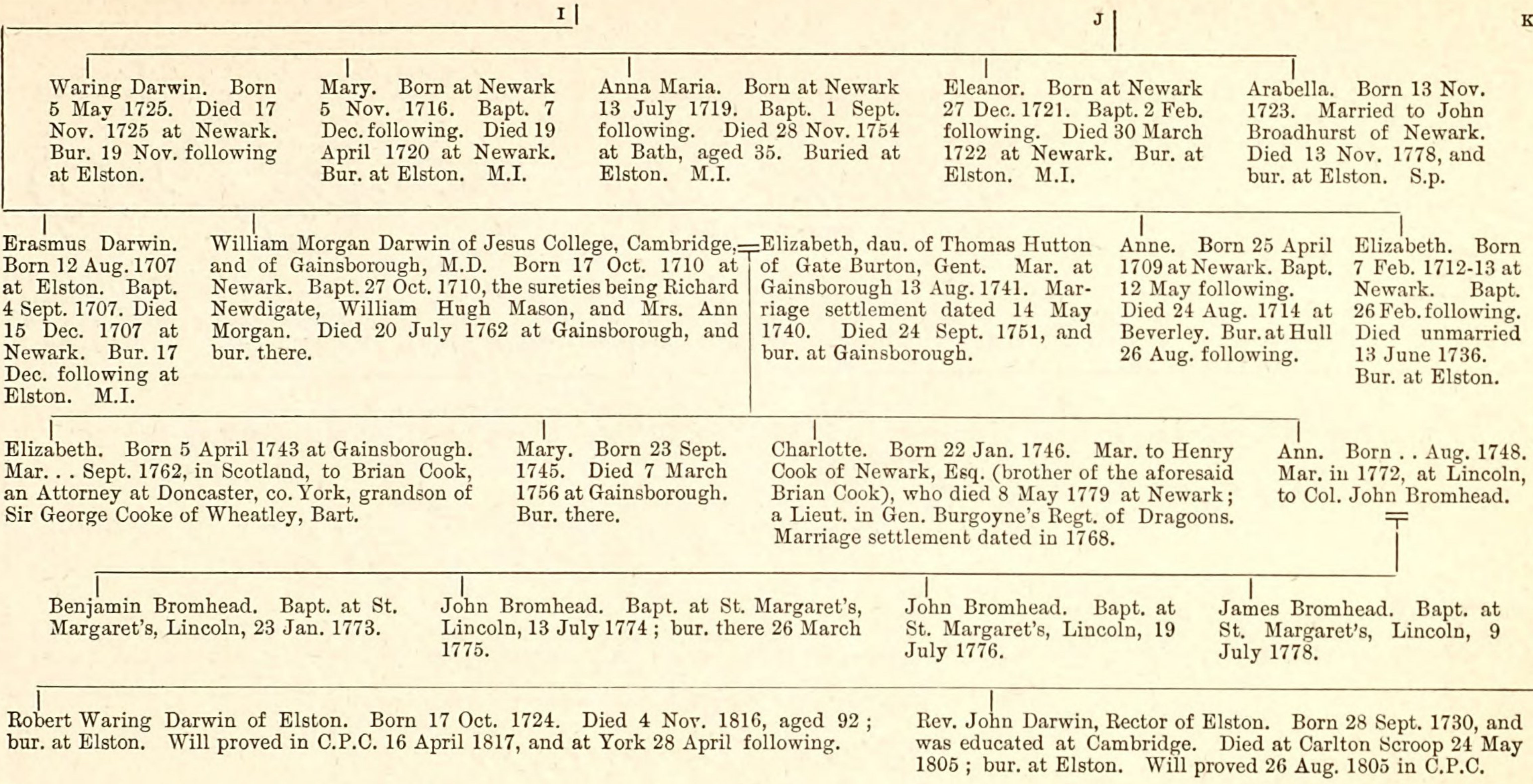

3rd wife, Mary Hurst of Grant-ham. Born 18 Dec. 1705. Mar. 26 Oct. 1749 at Thorpe. Died 1 Jan. 1766; bur. at Grantham.

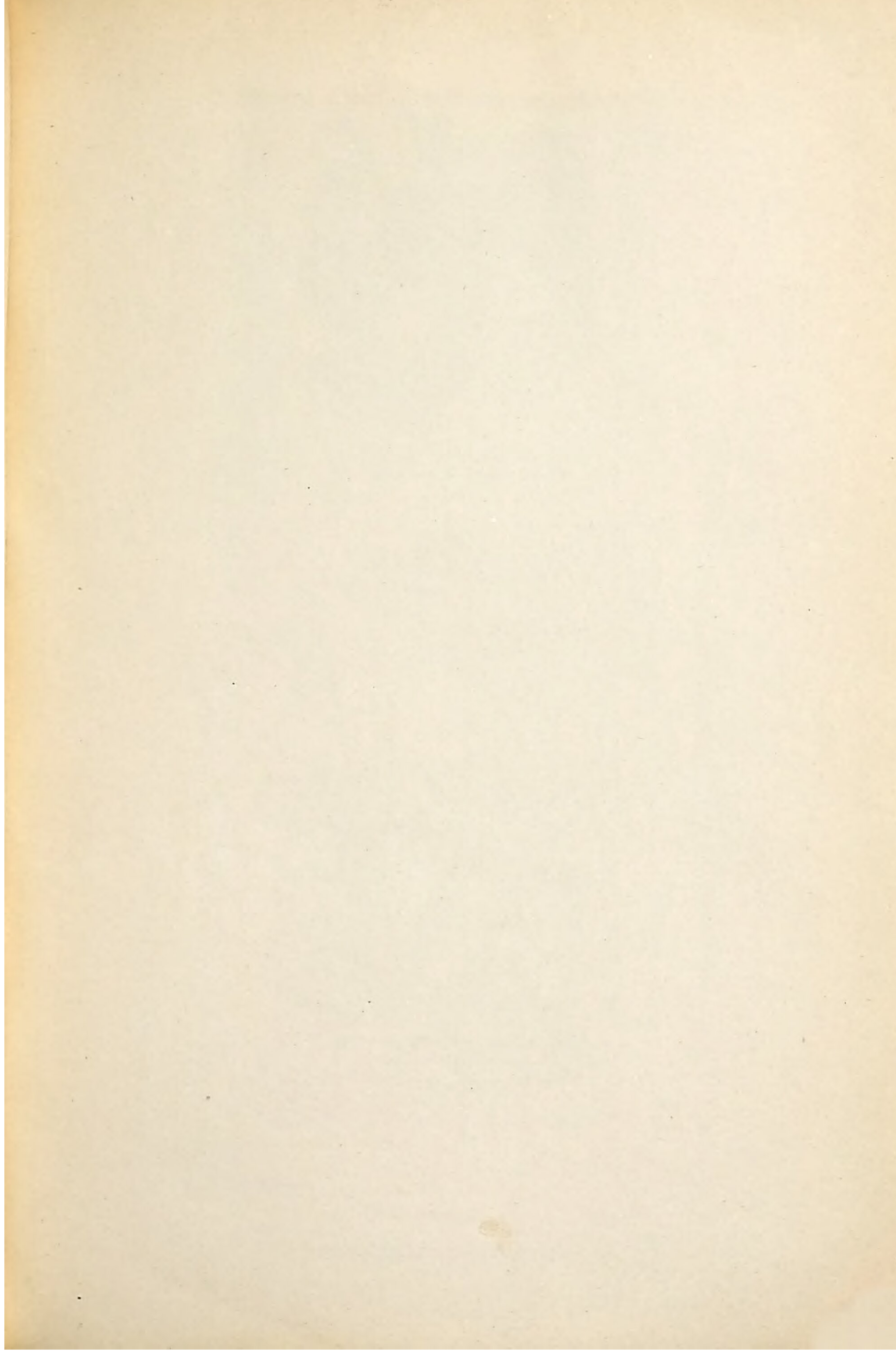


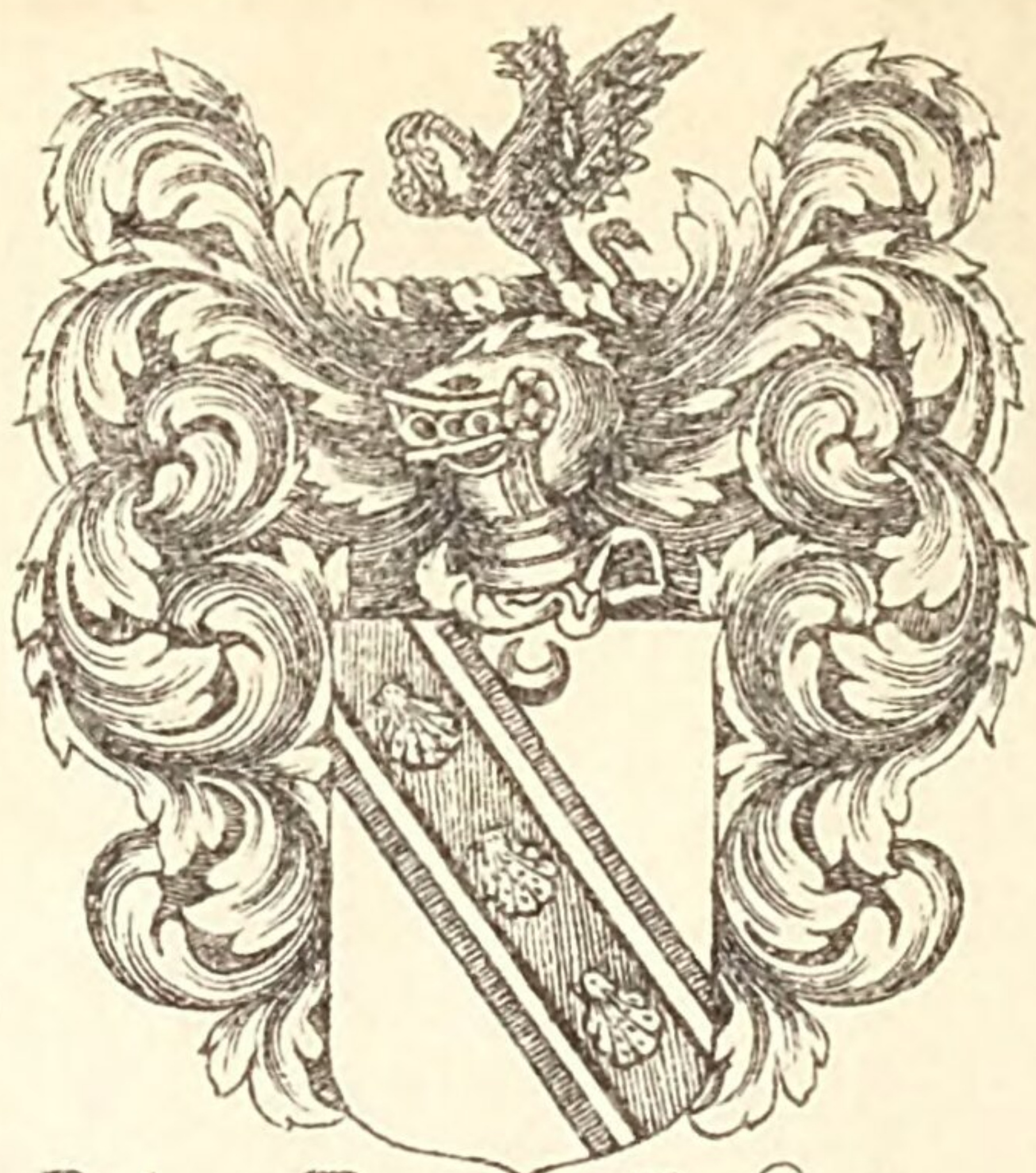

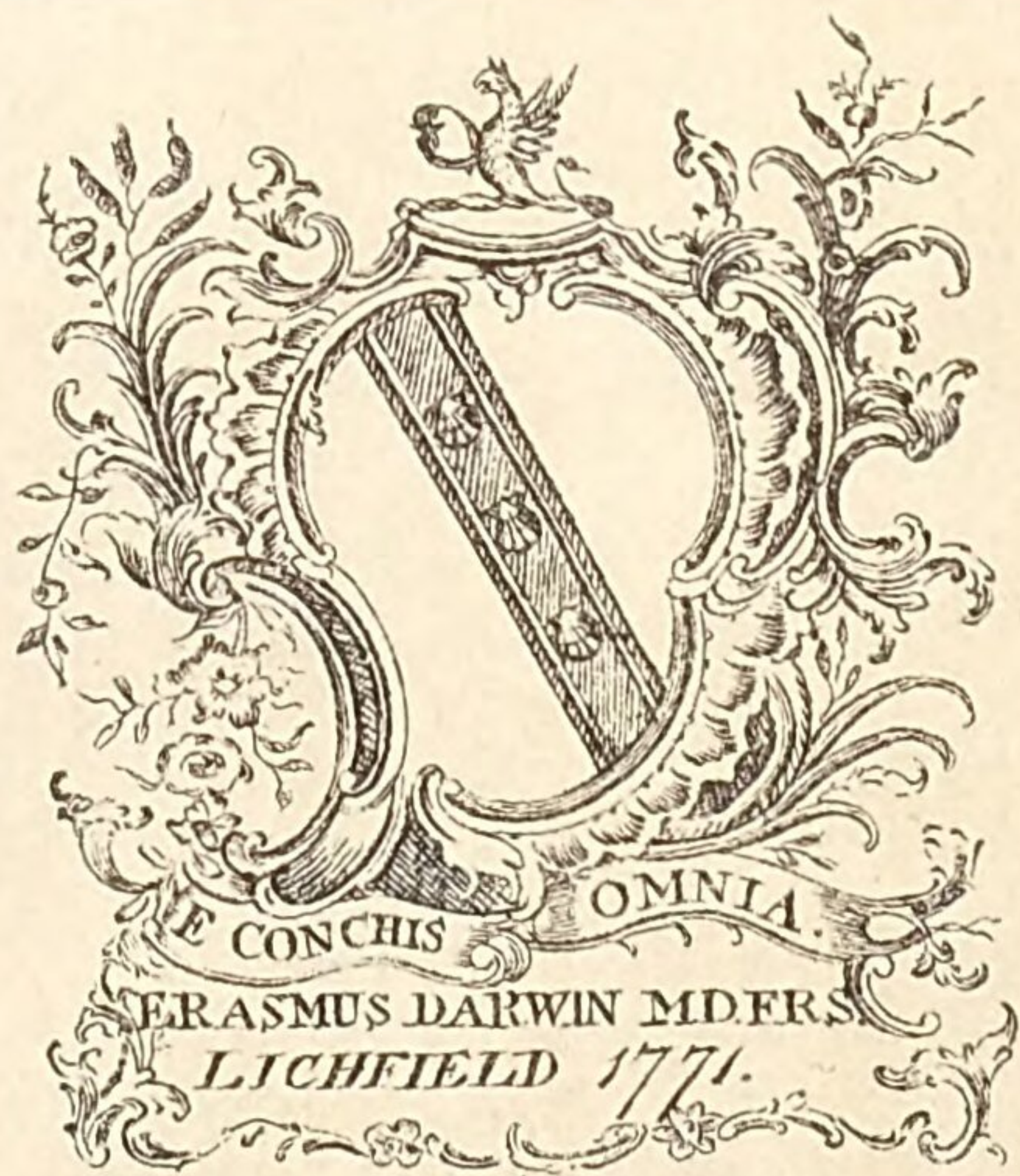

Jane Brown of Swineshead, co. Lincoln, dau. of Joseph Brown of Swineshead, co. Lincoln, and afterwards of Balderton, co. Notts. Born 29 Sept. 1746. Mar. 28 Oct. 1772 at Elston. Bur. at Breadsall, near Derby. The well-known Poet and Philosopher. Author of 'The Botanic Garden,' 'The Loves of the Plants,' etc. M.I. in Lichfield Cathedral.

Signature of Erasmus Darwin to a letter, dated 18 July 1783, addressed to "Josiah Wedgwood, Esq., Etruria, Newcastle, Staffordshire."

2nd wife, Elizabeth, dau. of . . . Collier, and widow of Colonel Edward Sacheverel Chandos-Pole (who died 27 Nov. 1780) of Radborne, near Derby. Born in 1747. Mar. 6 March 1781. Died 5 Feb. 1832.

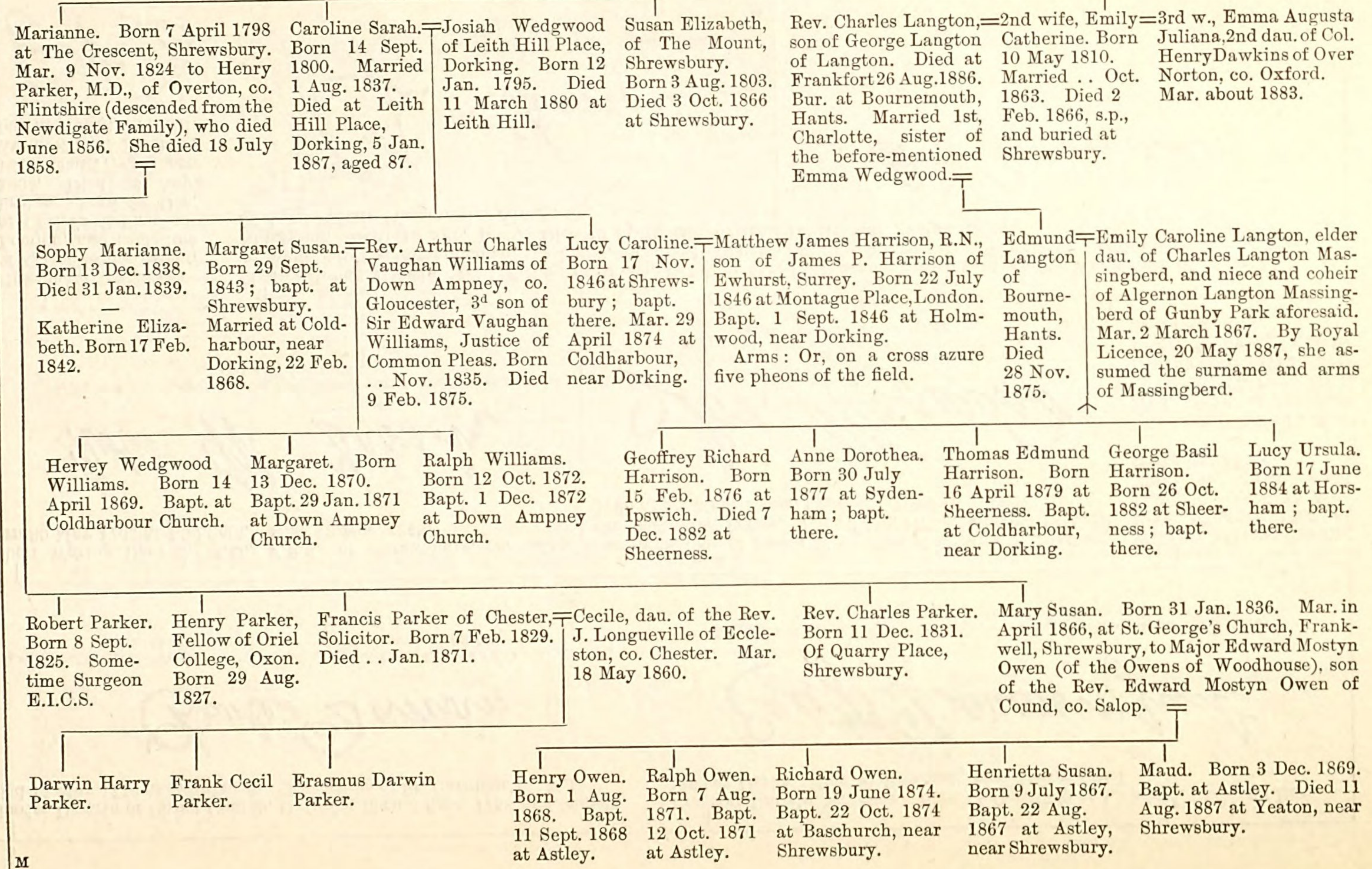
