Elizabeth, dau. of . . . Will dated 1 June 1593, and proved 26 Oct. 1594 at Lincoln. Buried in Marton Church.

Henry Darwin of Hardwick in the parish of Torksey, co. Lincoln, Yeoman. Will dated 23 June, and proved 4 July 1566 in C.P.C. (Crymes 19).

I. Rowland Darwin of Marton, Yeoman. Ex'or of his father's will. Bur. in Marton Church. Will dated 10 May, and proved 29 May 1588 at Lincoln. = Elizabeth, dau. of . . . Living 10 May 1588. Ex'trix of her husband's will.

II. Henry Darwin of Fenton in the parish of Kettlethorpe, co. Lincoln, Yeoman. Will dated 20 April 1590. Died 22 April 1590. Inq. p.m. dated 9 May 1590. Heir to his brother Rowland. Ex'or of his uncle Henry Darwin's will.

= Ann Fox, sister of Hugh Fox, whom she appointed ex'or of her will, dated 23 May, and proved 13 Oct. 1590 in C.P.C. (Drury 64-5). Ex'trix of her husband's will. Bur. in Kettlethorpe Church.

I. William Darwin of Lincoln, Yeoman or Gentleman. Born . . . Nov. 1573. Died 24 Oct. 1614, and bur. same day at St. Margaret's, Lincoln. Inq. p.m. dated 11 April 1615. = Martha, dau. of John Harris of Lincoln, Notary and Registrar of the Archdeaconsry of Stowe. Bapt. at St. Margaret's, Lincoln, 1 July 1586. Marriage settlement dated . . . Feb. 1603-4. She remarried 31 July 1611 John Holdenby, at St. Martin's, Lincoln.

John Darwin (youngest son) of Fenton, Yeoman. Born between 1569 and 1580. Died unmar. 9 Jan. 1638-9; bur. in Kettlethorpe Church. Will dated 9 May 1637; proved 6 Feb. 1638-9 at Lincoln. Inq. p.m. dated 18 Sept. 1639.

Dorothy (eldest dau.), wife of . . . Holland. Probably born 1569. Living 1593. Ex'trix of her father's will.

Ann, wife of . . . Browne. Born post 1569. Died ante 9 May 1637. Ex'trix of her father's will.

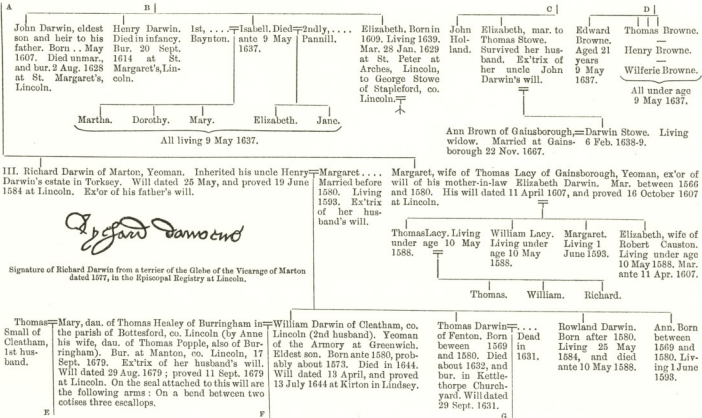
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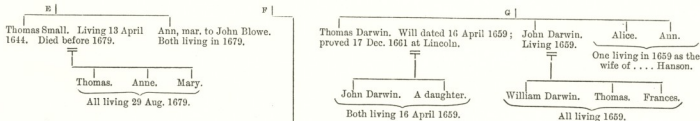

William Darwin of Lincoln's Inn. Born 6 June 1620. Ex'or of his father's will. Marriage settlement dated 2 June 1653. Recorder of the City of Lincoln. Will dated 20 Feb. 1673-4; codicil 24 Aug. 1675; proved 23 Nov. 1675 in C.P.C. (Dyce 110).

Signature of William Darwin to a Petition to the King dated May 1690.—' Domestic State Papers, Chas. II., vol. i., p. 128.

Anne, dau. of Erasmus Earle of Heydon (son of Thomas Earle, Esq., of Salle, co. Norf., by Anne, dau. of John Fountain, Esq.), by Frances, dau. of James Fountain of Salle, Esq. Born 24 April, bapt. at Heydon 1 May 1634. Married 30 Aug. 1653 at Clerkenwell Parish Church, co. Midd. Ex'trix of her husband's will. In her will, dated 22 Aug. 1691, described as of St. Andrew's, Holborn, co. Midd., widow. Bur. at Manton 2 Dec. 1691. Erasmus Earle, Esq., was bapt. 20 Sept. 1590. Of Lincoln's Inn 7 April 1612. Secretary for the English at the Treaty of Uxbridge, with Thurloe and Milton. Serjeant-at-Law 1648. Recorder of Norwich and Member also during the long Parliament. Own Serjeant to the Commonwealth to Oliver and to Richard Cromwell. Pardoned by King Charles II. 21 June 1660. Buried 10 Sept. 1667. Will dated 31 Aug. 1667; proved in C.P.C. 29 Nov. 1667 (Carr. 149-150).

Thomas Darwin. Living 1679 and probably 1695-6. Ex'or of the wills of his father and brother.

Elizabeth, dau. of . . . Adm'on of her estate granted in the C.P.C. 19 Feb. 1695-6.

- III. John Darwin. Born at Norwich 21 and died 27 April 1661; bur. at Heydon.
- IV. Richard Darwin of St. George's, Southwark, co. Surrey, Gentleman. Born 3 April 1663 in Holborn, and bapt. 3 April 1663 at St. Andrew's, Holborn. Ex'or of the will of his brother Francis Darwin. Died unmar. Will dated 27 July 1698; proved 13 Aug. 1698 in C.P.C. (Lort 184).
- V. Francis Darwin of London, Merchant. Born 31 Dec. 1669 in the parish of St. Martin's, Lincoln. Died unmar. in the East Indies. Will dated 3 April 1693; proved 27 May 1696 in C.P.C. (Bond 64).
- Ann. Born 2 Feb. 1664-5 in Castle Yard, Holborn. Bapt. 2 Feb. 1664-5 at St. Andrew's, Holborn. Mar. settlement dated 15 Nov. 1686. Died 22 Dec. 1743. Will dated 5 May 1740, then of St. Leonard, Eastcheap, London, widow; proved 22 Dec. 1743 by Henry Little, sole ex'or.
- Henry Randes, Citizen and Haberdasher of London. Will, in which he is described as of St. Mary, Newington, Surrey, dated 18 Nov. 1723; proved 30 Dec. 1723 by Ann Randes the relict.
- William Darwin. Living 29 Aug. 1679 under age.
- Mary. Living 29 Aug. 1679 underage.

Richard Randes, sometime Master of the Merchant Ship the Pindar Galley. Died unmarried. Adm'on 23 June 1715 to his father Henry Randes.

Erasmus Randes of Newington Butts, Surrey. Died in the Merchant Ship "Northampton." Adm'on 17 Sept. 1723 to Hanna Cheney, widow, principal creditor, the relict, Hanna Randes, renouncing.

Hanna. 1st husb. . . . Little. 2nd husb. Ann. Carew Weekes or Wickes.

Henry Little of St. Leonard's, Eastcheap, pewterer. Proved his grandmother's will 22 Dec. 1743.

I. William Darwin. Born 27 July 1655 at Southampton Buildings in the parish of St. Andrew's, Holborn, co. Middx., and bapt. there 5 Aug. following. Died 28 and bur. 29 Aug. 1682 at Elston. M.I.

Anne, only dau. and heir of Robert Waring of Wilford, co. Notts (who was buried at Wilford 12 Feb. 1662), by Anne his wife, who mar. secondly George Lascelles of Elston. Became possessed of Elston Hall, co. Notts. Bapt. at Wilford 16 Jan. 1662. Mar. at Heydon 9 Sept. 1680. Died at Elston 23 May 1722, aged 58 years. Will dated 18 May 1722. Bur. 26 May following in chancel of Elston Church. M.I.

Robert Darwin of Elston, co. Notts, and of Lincoln's Inn, Barrister-at-Law. Born 12 Aug. 1682. Died 20 Nov. 1754 at Elston, aged 72; bur. at Elston. M.I.

Elizabeth, dau. of Thomas Hutton of Gate Burton, Gent. Mar. at Gainsborough 13 Aug. 1741. Marriage settlement dated 14 May 1740. Died 24 Sept. 1751, and bur. at Gainsborough.

Anne. Born 25 April 1709 at Newark. Bapt. 12 May following. Died 24 Aug. 1714 at Beverley. Bur. at Hull 26 Aug. following.




