Brown colour chiefly confined to upper epidermis cells: there seems no injury to the chlorophyll. The lower surface epidermis is also brown especially about the midrib. There is some brown in the vessels -

Camia-

The brown colour ~~on the~~ is confined
to the epidermis cells, & is quite as
strongly marked on the lower surface
of the leaf: the chlorophyll grains are not
distinct, so that ^{some of} the cells are full of
homogenous green pulp; but this is also
the case in parts of the leaf which are
not brown.
